The HPO holds the heart of our city's identity.

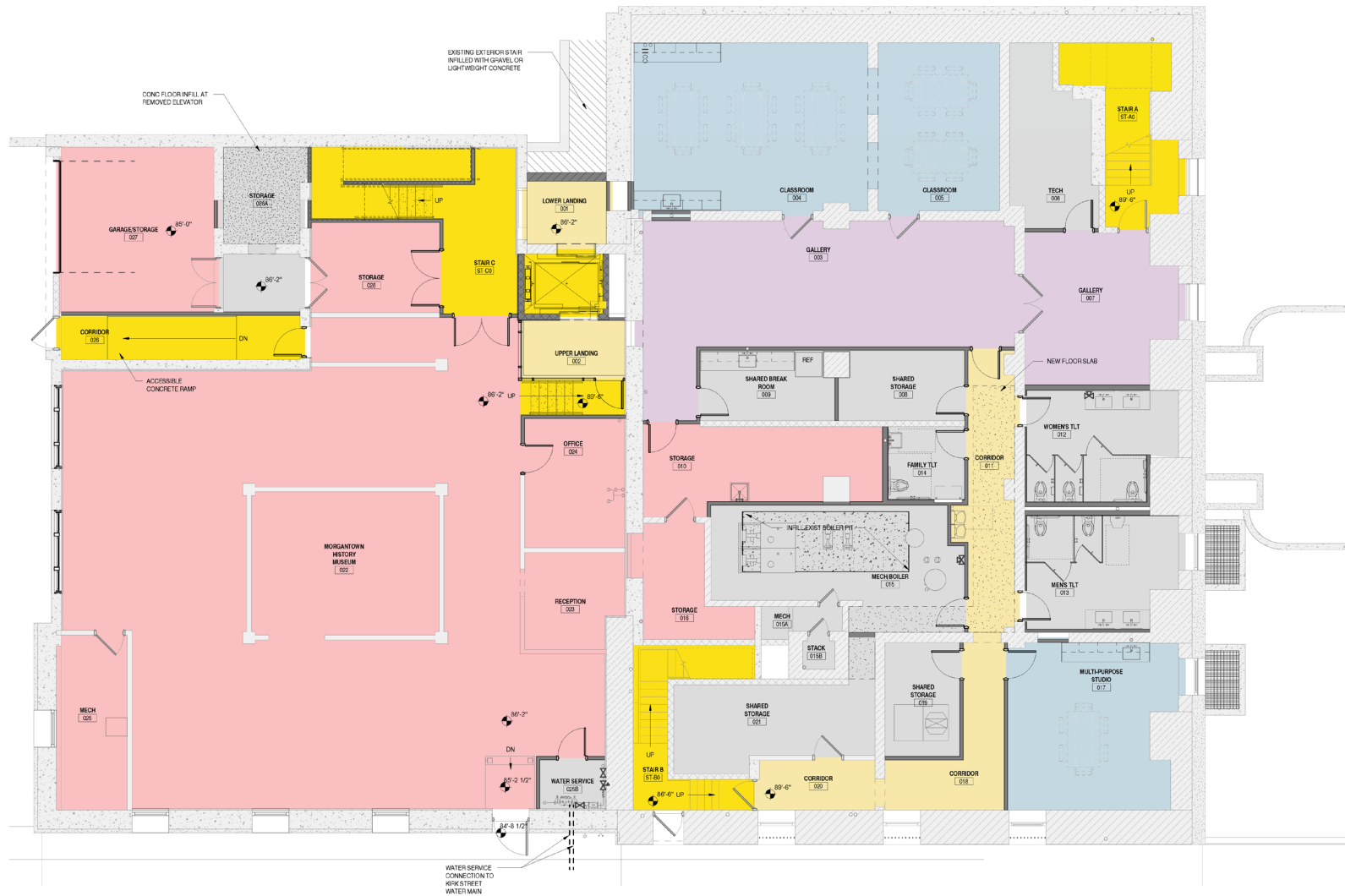
Inside its walls, more than 15,000 artifacts bring the history of our people, industries, and culture to life.

THEATRE

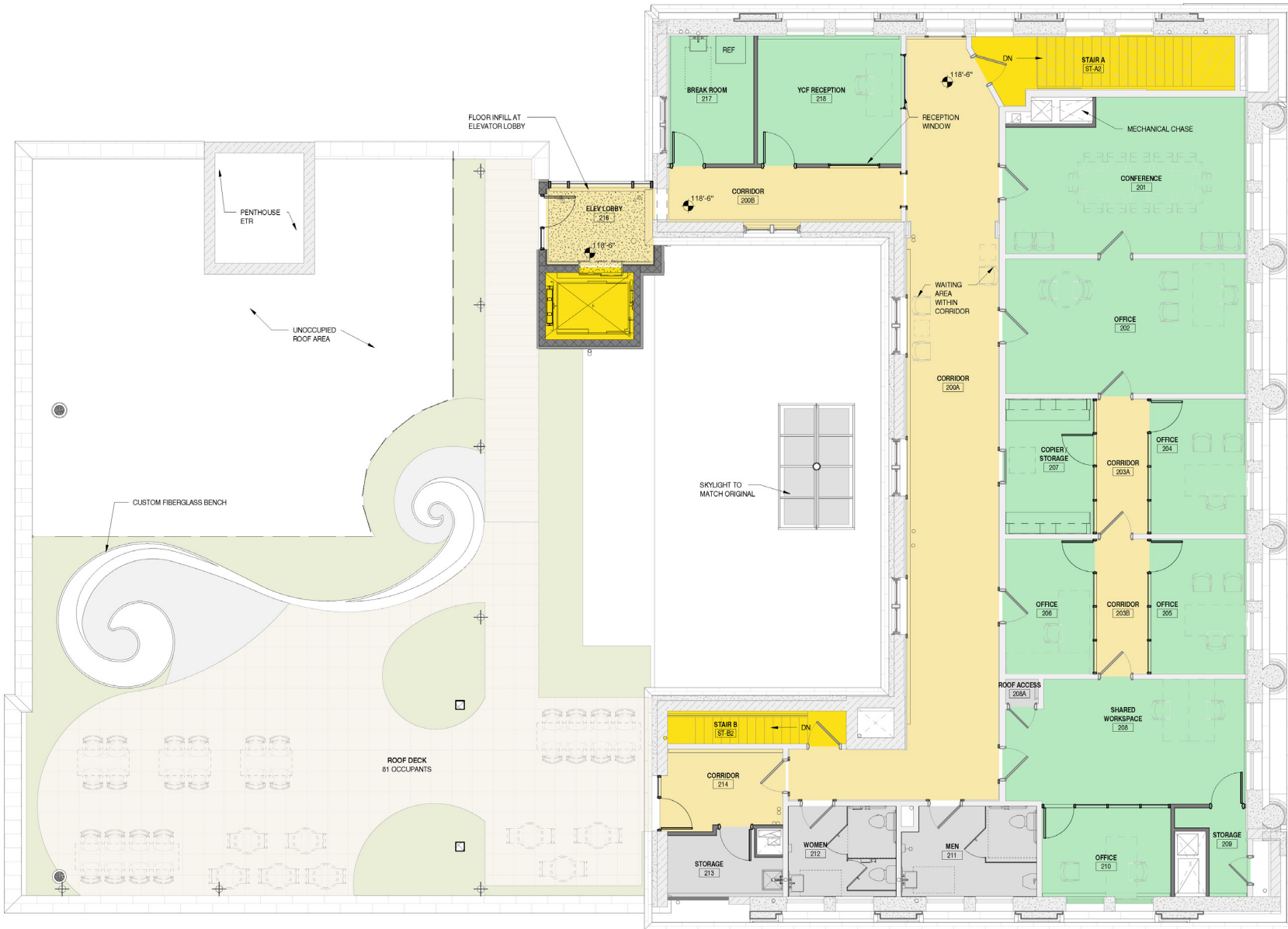


The community's arts education center, cultural exhibit, gallery space, and theatre—all wrapped into one.

The first level will house a theater, cafe, gallery, and workshop spaces.



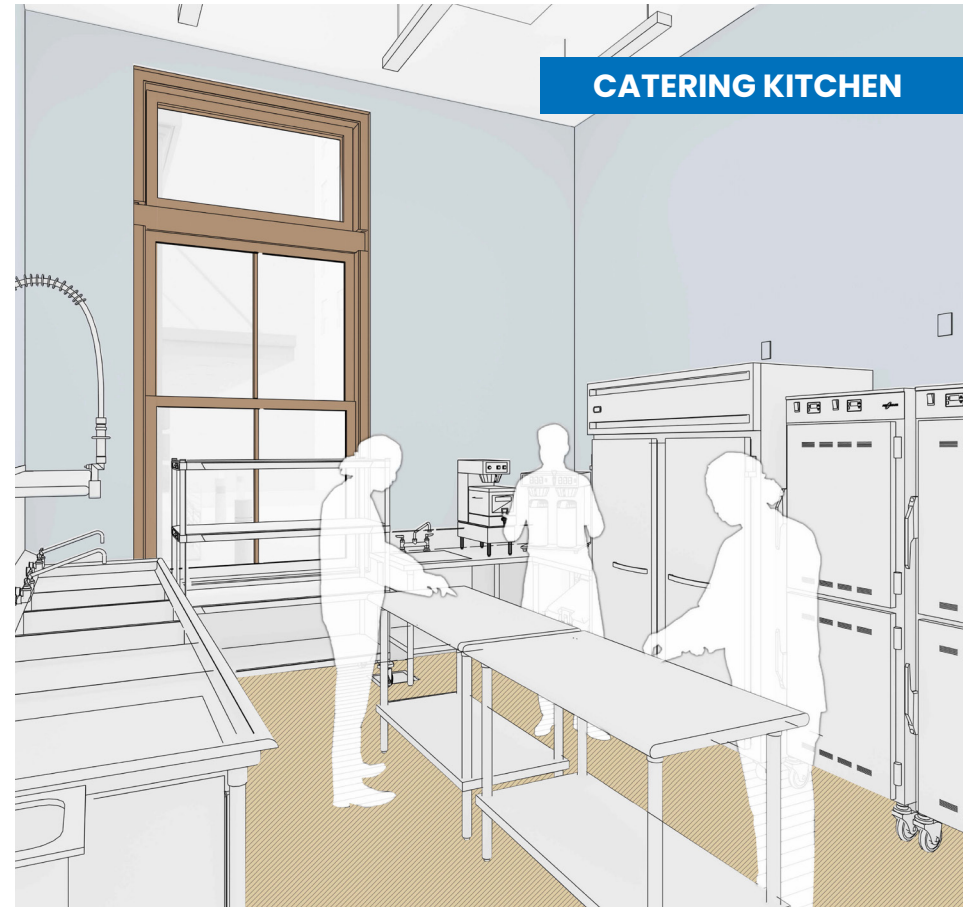
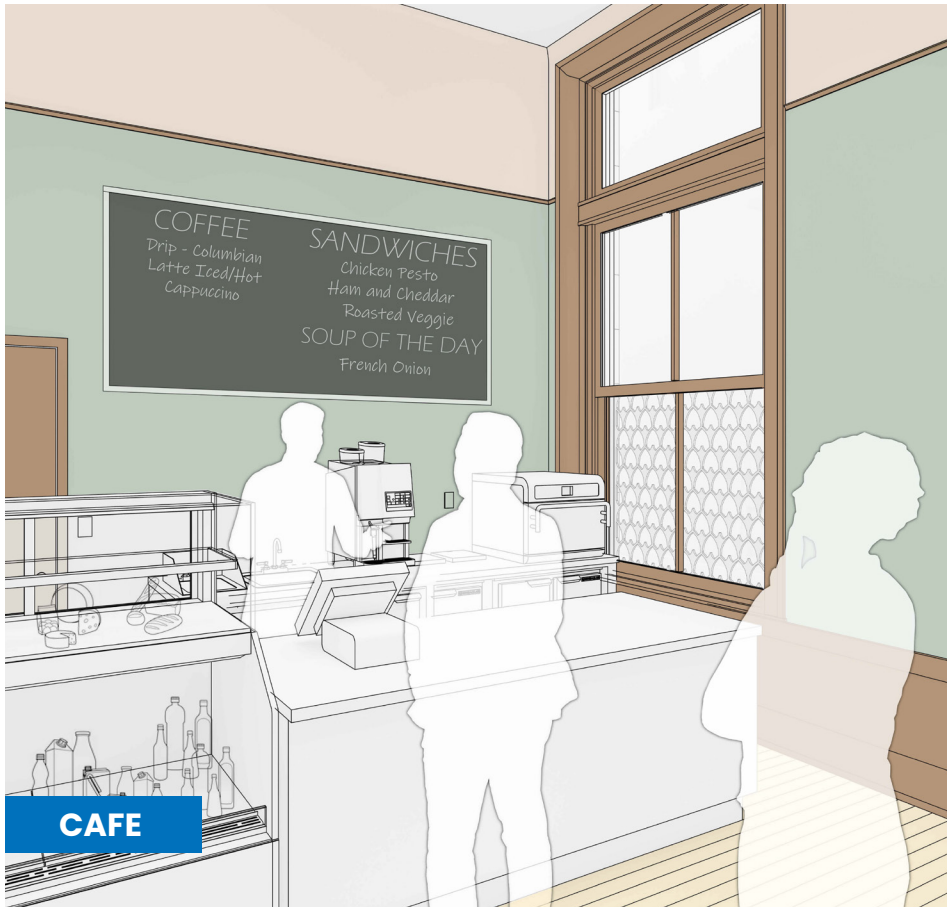


A LOOK INSIDE: SECOND LEVEL FLOOR PLAN

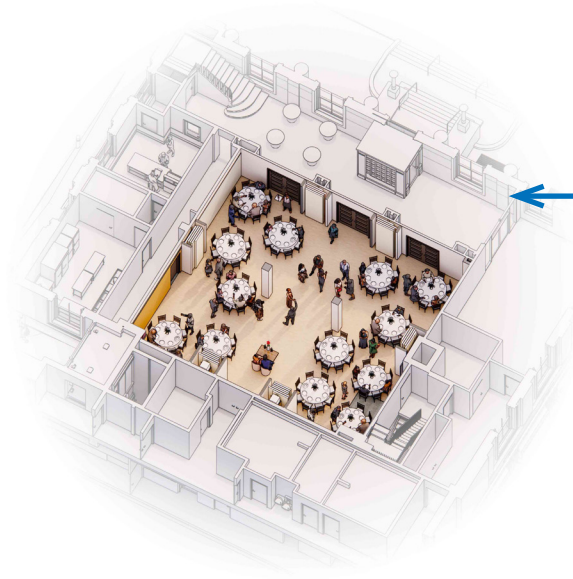
State-of-the-Art Catering Kitchen

MULTIPURPOSE ROOM: FLEXIBLE ROOM LAYOUTS FOR ANY OCCASION

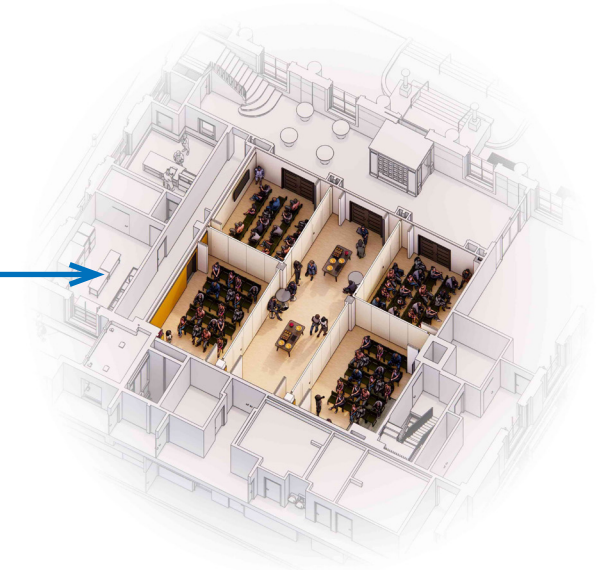
The redeveloped HPO will serve as the perfect place for community to gather, offering a variety of room layouts to accommodate a wide range of events.

The space can be easily transformed to host large receptions, multi-room conferences and workshops.



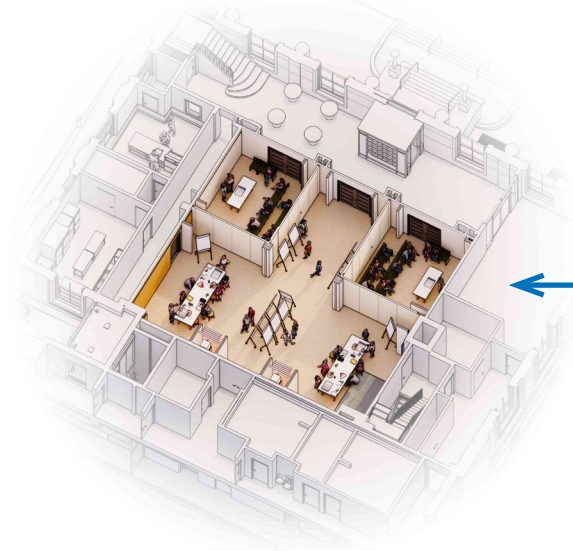
RECEPTION
